| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Governed by informal rules and procedures which enhance cooperation, diminish confrontation.</li><li>• Involves the intervention of a knowledgeable, experienced third party - The FLT Mediator.</li><li>• Parties control the outcome - no fixed remedies - Creative “Win-Win” solutions are possible. Focus on real interests, not inflexible positions.</li><li>• Parties control the process - counsel and other professionals may participate and assist.</li><li>• Mediator serves at the discretion of the disputing parties, and the process can be terminated at any time by the parties or the mediator.</li><li>• Mediation is an extension of the negotiation process, enhances direct negotiation, and works even when negotiation does not.</li></ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Mediator can enhance/assist/restore/clear communications - can create a climate and process for future cooperation on personal, business, or other issues.</li><li>• Mediator is not an adjudicator, trier of fact, fact finder, arbitrator, jury or judge. The parties determine the outcome.</li><li>• Mediation avoids the possibility of months or years of litigation and appeals.</li><li>• Parties file confidential pre-mediation statements with the DPR mediator in advance of the mediation proceeding</li><li>• Characteristics of a good mediator: Perceptive, patient, articulate, experienced, knowledgeable of subject matter, self-confident, trustworthy</li></ul> |
